

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. One class of entry only. Entry fee: £25 per rider. No more than 4 riders per group.
2. Late entries: £30 per rider. Late entries will be allocated available start times Entries will be taken on the day if room.
3. Entries & fees to be received no later than 4th September
4. All riders under 16 should be accompanied by an adult.
5. All riders must have appropriate third party liability insurance.
6. Start times will be between 9.30am and 1pm. Requests for specific start times should be included on your entry form. We will endeavour to fit you in as close as possible but we cannot guarantee you will get the exact start time you ask for. The earlier you submit your entry the more likely it is we will be able to accommodate you. Note, if you are likely to be 'going slowly' please request a start time before 12 noon.
7. Please enclose an SAE with your entry form and fee for return notification of your start time. This notification should be presented to the Secretary when you declare.

Information for the day

Doddington Place is situated just 15 minutes from the A20 and A2. It is clearly signposted. Access to the park is via the main gate, please follow signs as we will operate a one way system. Please park where directed by the stewards.

Report to the Secretary's tent to declare at least 30 minutes before your allotted start time and collect your number bib. **£5 refundable deposit will be required for your bib.**

At your allotted start time report to the start marshal.

It is the individual's responsibility to wear protective headgear and appropriate footwear. All riders must wear hats to current

British Safety standards with a chin strap secured at three points and fastened under the chin at all times when mounted.

The route will be clearly marked and marshals will be present around the course. First Aid facilities are available at the start/finish area. A vet will be on call. If you require assistance during the ride please inform one of the marshals who will do their best to help. Please obey the marshal's instructions. Most of the course is cross country but there will be some riding on quiet country lanes and some road crossings. Please be courteous to other road users, other riders and observers on foot.

Optional jumping is around the course and will be of varying heights. Not all fences will be stewarded. No more than 3 attempts at each jump. There is no point scoring.

All fences outside the Charity Ride are strictly out of bounds. On completion please report back to the Secretary, hand in your bib and collect your rosette.

Refreshment will be available in the start/finish area.

The legal bit

No responsibility will be accepted by the Ashford Valley Tickham Hunt, the organisers, the landowners, their servants or agents for any death or injury to any persons, animals or loss or damage to property, howsoever caused, arising out of or as a consequence of the organisation of this event.

All riders will be asked to sign a disclaimer when declaring.

All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
